**Directions from Aiken:** Take I-20 towards Columbia, take exit 39 (North) towards Camp Agape. Pass by Camp Agape on US-178 and turn slightly right on SC-245 (South Lee Street). Proceed through Batesburg/Leesville on SC-245. Turn slightly right onto SC-391 (Summerland Avenue) and continue through the round-about at Round-O staying on SC-391. SC-391 becomes Main Street when you reach Prosperity.

**Directions from Columbia:** Take I-26 West towards Greenville/Spartanburg. Take exit 82 towards Prosperity on SC-773 (Wheeler Street). When SC-773 ends turn right onto US 76 and then turn left on Langford Street (SC-S-36-516). Cross over the railroad tracks and turn into the Wightman parking lot.

**Directions from Sumter:** Proceed to Columbia and take I-26 West. Proceed as above in directions from Columbia.
