Dear Friends,

The month of May is a busy one with several special occasions. Mother's Day falls on May 13th and many churches will recognize their graduates this month. What wonderful occasions in our life together! Also on the Christian calendar this month are three special Sundays: Ascension, Pentecost and Trinity Sunday.
