Starving in a Pie Factory, A Fourth Day Reflection

I was once invited to a friend's house for dinner. His father, Dave, traveled as a contractor, and told a story of working in Florida as we ate. Dave said that he was talking to another contractor there while on break and complained that he was hungry. His new friend replied, "Man, if you're hungry in Florida, you would starve in a pie factory." His friend showed Dave how to dig up clams, and Dave went back to work full and happy.

Much like in a pie factory, there is an abundance of food available to us as Christians. We are instructed to pray to Him to give us this day our daily bread, and assured in Psalms 81:10, "Open wide thy mouth, and I will fill it." This is true for our physical AND spiritual food needs. In Matthew 4:4, Jesus rebuked Satan, saying, "It is written: 'Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word that comes from the mouth of God." Our Lord continually invites us to the banquet to eat.

Dave's 40-year-old story showed back up for me this month as I talked to people about starting or

joining a reunion group. I often heard some version of the story told by Dave. Some of the people I approached to ask about starting or joining a reunion group told me that they are so busy doing work in their church or community



that adding another action felt overwhelming. In the next breath they would often tell me that they were WORN. DOWN. (HUNGRY!) I felt mildly shocked by this information. For me, my reunion groups offer a chance for all of us to feast on piety and study. Don't get me wrong. I do organize and coordinate dinner when it is our turn to host, so action is also involved. This action isn't an expenditure, though. It is an investment with a guaranteed return. My reunion groups are where I refuel when I get spiritually hungry. It's not another chore on a list of things to do any more than eating when I'm physically hungry is something to miss because I am too busy. Spiritual nutrition is even more important when I am engaged with heavy discipleship actions that require a lot of spiritual energy to complete.

As disciples, we pour ourselves out. There is always more need than there is us to go around. It is so important to recognize that one of the people in our world that needs replenishing is us. Me. You. Us. Our daily bread was so important to Jesus that he instructed us to petition for it in the Lord's prayer. We cannot pour from an empty cup. Will you consider who might be able to help you replenish, and start a reunion group with them? It might just be the pie factory you've been waiting for.

We hope to see everyone there!


